Where: The picturesque Wisconsin River Valley in Spring Green, Wisconsin, a haven for artists and artisans.

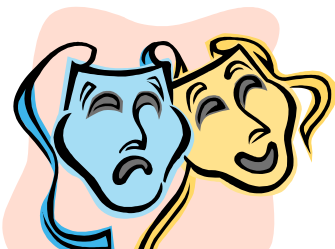
When: Friday, September 26 and Saturday, September 27, 2008
